## Materials

**Styrofoam Eggs – Amazon**

**Markers**

**Paint**

**Gems**

**Pom poms**

**Feathers**

**Glue**

## How To

**1. Decorate your styrofoam egg!**





# Easter Play-Dough



## Materials

**2 cups all-purpose flour**  
**3/4 cup salt**  
**4 teaspoons cream of tartar**  
**2 cups lukewarm water**  
**2 Tablespoons of vegetable oil**  
**Food coloring**  
**craft elements**

## How To

- 1. Stir together the flour, salt and cream of tartar in a large pot**
- 2. Next add the warm water and oil**
- 3. stir in the the color now**
- 4. Keep stirring until dough is no longer sticky**
- 5. \*Keep adding in more flour to help with the stickiness**
- 6. Time to play with your Easter play dough!**







# Magnetic Easter Egg Hunt



## Materials

**Tray or plastic tub**  
**Easter Grass**  
**Plastic eggs**  
**Small magnets**  
**Magnet stick**

## How To

- 1. Put Easter grass in tub or tray**
- 2. Put a small magnet(s) in the eggs and tape shut**
- 3. Place eggs in the grass**
- 4. Use the magnet stickers to go on your Easter egg hunt!**







# Egg Balance!



## Materials

**Cardboard Box**  
**Straws or skewers**  
**Plastic eggs**

## How To

- 1. Start by poking hole on the top on the box**
- 2. Place straws or skewers in the poked holes**
- 3. Now try to balance the eggs on top of the straws!**



# Chickpea Sensory Fun!

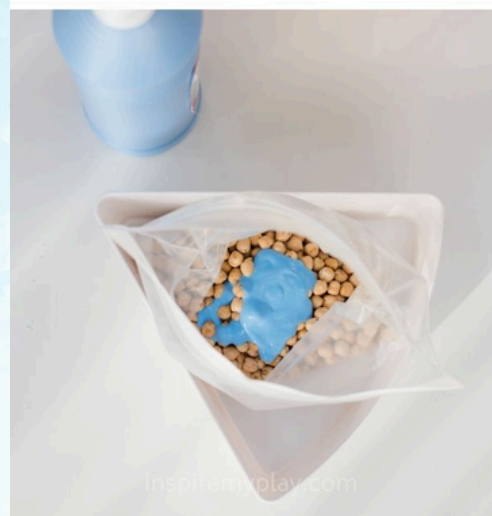


## Materials

**Dried chickpeas**  
**Zip-lock/ sandwich bags**  
**Tempera or acrylic paint**  
**Tray for drying the painted chickpeas**

## How To

1. Fill a sandwich bag with chickpeas and add a few generous squirts of tempera/acrylic paint
2. Work the paint into the chickpeas by scrunching and shaking the bag. Open the bag and check if they need a little more paint or scrunching in order to be completely covered
3. Lay them out on a lined baking tray to dry
4. Repeat the process for different colors using a different bag
5. Once dry, pour them into a tray with scoops and bowls and other sensory play tools







# Egg Match

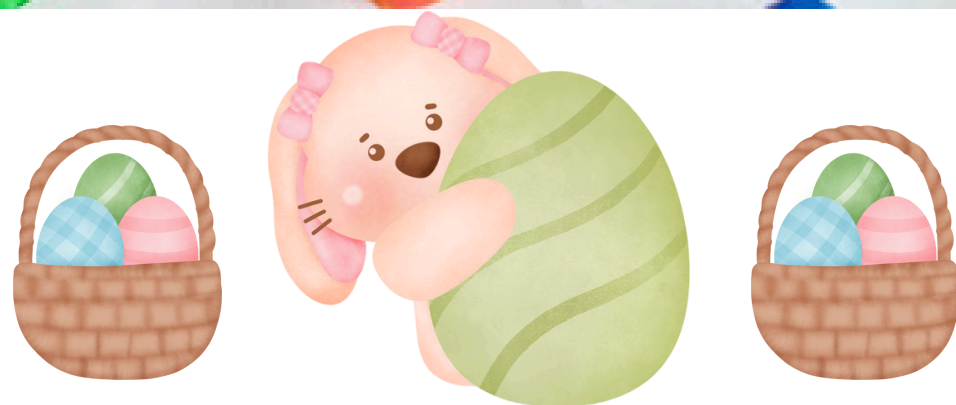


## Materials

**Plastic eggs**  
**Dot markers**  
**Paper**  
**Tape**

## How To

- 1. Tape down a piece of paper to a hard surface**
- 2. Use markers to make multiple dots on paper**
- 3. Use the eggs to match the colors that are on the paper!**







# Fizzy Eggs



## Materials

**Plastic eggs**  
**Baking Soda**  
**Vinegar**  
**Food Coloring**

## How To

- 1. Take tops off of plastic eggs and place in a plastic carton**
- 2. Add a few drops of food coloring to each egg**
- 3. Then add a spoonful of baking soda to each egg**
- 4. Pour some vinegar in each egg and watch them fizz!**
