


Today, I am going to LaunchPAD Children's Museum!

I can put my stuff in a locker or hang up my coat on the rack.




There is stroller parking here too!



There are **bathrooms** located at the front and back of the museum.






I can tell my grown up if I need to go to the bathroom before I start to play.

If other kids are playing with the toys, I can ask to play with them. If they say "no", it's okay! I can wait until they are done.






I can use a cart to shop for groceries at the Market.

There are aprons available if I don't want to accidentally get my clothes wet. When I am done, I can dry my hands with the hand dryer!


If I get thirsty, I can get a drink at the water fountain.




I can also buy food at the concession stand. I eat it at the tables so I don't get the rest of the museum messy.




At the Wind Zone I can make objects float and move with air!

At the treehouse, I can climb the stairs and go down the slide!




This is a good place to go when I need a calm area.

There are other children that come to the museum to play and have fun like me! We take turns playing with the toys.




If I feel upset or overwhelmed, I can go to the Sensory Room to calm down.

I am aware of my body when I am climb and pay attention to where other children are climbing too.




The Infant and Toddler area is a padded area where little ones can play.
